
## Road Closure

From Monday 13 October 2008, for approximately 22 weeks, Jersey Water's contractor, Jayen Limited, will commence the laying of the first phase of a strategic trunk water main primarily to reinforce and improve the security of supply to the north east parts of the distribution network.

Construction works will start at the junction of La Rue du Boulay towards St Martin's Arsenal and will be closed to through traffic.

Road users travelling east will be diverted along La Rue des Bouillons, whilst road users westbound from St Martin's area will be prompted to travel via Five Oaks.

Though signs will be placed at strategic locations, road users should use an alternative route where possible.

Other points to note:

- 3a, 3b and 23 bus services will continue as normal to the Durrell Centre. Once the works passes Durrell the 3a, 3b and 23 bus services will terminate at St Martin's Arsenal.
- 2. Access to Durrell Centre will be maintained. Please follow the signs.
- 3. Over the Christmas holiday period all roads will be opened and will be closed again on Monday 5 January 2009.
