
## Victoria Street Water Mains Renewal

Starting from Monday 11 October



The existing water mains in Victoria Street, St Helier are 80 years old and have suffered several bursts over the last few years. Starting on **Monday 11 October**, Jersey Water plan to use a new method to structurally re-line the mains. Services to all properties will also be renewed and once complete, will last for another 80 years.

For the first 3-4 weeks Jersey Water will be installing new valves and renewing customer supply pipes. Once this section of work is complete, UK specialists will take 4 days to clean and re-line the pipes.

Jersey Water is aware that working in town affects many people and businesses, which is why we only renew pipes when we have to. The new method of working will reduce disruption, taking only 4-5 weeks compared to the 10 weeks if we used traditional methods. As part of the new working method, only a few holes will need to be dug rather than trenches the full length of the road.

During the period of work, Jersey Water will have to close Victoria Street to through traffic to enable works to be completed quickly and more efficiently.

## All businesses will remain open as normal and access to premises will be maintained throughout our works.
