What is DAMC? The Donna Annand Melanoma Charity (DAMC) was set up in memory of Donna Annand to educate Islanders of the dangers of malignant melanoma. Our key message is prevention, protection and early detection.

Every year in Jersey:

- On average 300 Islanders are diagnosed with some form of skin cancer
- On average 40 Islanders are diagnosed with Malignant Melanoma
- On average 3 Islanders die from Malignant Melanoma

Donna's Story Donna Annand (nee Le Saint) tragically passed away on 18 February 2011 following a long and brave battle against Stage IV malignant melanoma, aged only 29. Donna's wish was that this disease be highlighted to allow the early detection and treatment of melanoma to improve people's chances of survival, this resulted in the formation of the Donna Annand Melanoma Charity in June 2012.
